Tiruchirappalli Govindarajulu Lingappa

- Lingappa was born to a Telugu family in Trichy on August 22, 1927
- His father G. Govindarajulu Naidu was a well known music director who composed music for films such as Andamaan Kaithi, Kalvanin Kadhal and Baghdad Thirudan. Lingappa learned music from his dad during his early years in Trichy.
- His father owned a musical instruments shop in Trichy where Lingappa learned to play several instruments. In 1940, the family moved to Madras.
- Lingappa expanded his skill to play imported electric guitar and worked as a free lance musician for famous music directors- S V Venkatraman, C R Subbaraman, G Ramanathan, R.Sudarsanam , S.M.Subbiah Naidu and K V Mahadevan. He played several instruments including guitar.
- T R Mahalingam who was once a friend of his dad hired him as music director for his films Mohana Sundaram (1951), Chinnadurai and Vilayattu Bommai. Lingappa composed music for several Bharathiyan songs. Chandra Babu sang his first song in Mohana Sundaram.
- B R Panthulu gave ample opportunity to Lingappa for composing music in Tamil and Kannada films. In Kalyanam Panniyum Brahmachari, Lingappa got permission from Bharatidasan and M M Dhandapani Desikar to include “Vennilavum Vanum Pole” song in the film. The song has become an evergreen favorite of listeners. Mudhal Thethi had nice songs including N S Krishnan’s Onnule Irunthu. Amudhai Pozhiyum Nilave from Thangmalai Ragasiyum is still a listener’s choice. Other famous films are Sabash Meena and Muradan Muthu.
- He continued to work in films in Kannada ,Telugu and Malayalam until 1988.
- He died on Feb.5, 2000 at the age of 72. TGL had spent a career of three decades in South Indian Cinema and he will be remembered for many memorable tunes.
